# Technical areas

The Scottish Youth FA requests that all teams have in place two technical areas before the start of the match. The responsibility lies with the home team. Further guidance is shown overleaf.

# Match Day Pitch Set-Up Directive



## AWAY Supporters



## HOME Supporters

1. Technical areas – 4 x 2m
2. Technical areas should be on **opposite** sides of the pitch
3. Supporters should be 2m from the touchline
4. Supporters should spectate from the side allocated to their team's Technical area.
5. Where the synthetic pitch is enclosed, i.e., cage construction, all parents and supporters should remain outside the confines of the pitch.

***All teams are reminded that SYFA regulations dictate that they are responsible for the behaviour of their own supporters.***

The Scottish Youth FA instructs all teams and referees to ensure compliance with these requirements before the commencement of the match. It is recognised that due to the construction of the synthetic pitch or proximity to an adjacent pitch, these requirements may not be physically possible. In such circumstances, the SYFA asks that the home team make every effort to align as closely as possible with the directive.
